
Otis wakes up. It's dark outside.




Otis is hot.

Otis says, "Mommy my ear feels funny."




Otis cries, "Sniffle, snuffle, sniffle, snuffle."




His Dad says, "Don't worry, Otis, today you will see Dr. Green."




Dr. Green says, "Hmm. Hmm. Uh-huh."




Dr. Green says, "I'm going to give you some medicine for your earache, Otis."




Dr. Green says, "If you take *all* your medicine, Otis, your ear will feel better."
